## **Creation:**

- Build statewide programs to preserve, promote, and provide access to California's legacy collections
- Assist the State Library to design and implement other initiatives to create content with California's legacy collections
- Develop Web-based education and information services

## **Preservation:**

- Extend disaster preparedness services to all California institutions to protect investments in collections as well as preserve heritage materials
- Partner with California organizations on disaster preparedness initiatives to strengthen existing and create additional regional disaster preparedness networks
- Implement an outcomes-based preservation education program
- Integrate CPP services with regional and national preservation programs and centers to enhance effectiveness through collaborative and cooperative efforts, avoid duplicative costs, and direct national expertise to help meet State needs.
- Provide preservation assessments of collections to improve collection management, including development of assessment tools
- Partner with the cultural tourism community and other stakeholders to communicate the value and excitement of heritage preservation
